	1	Allow school districts the flexibility and option to administer paper-based standardized tests when deemed necessary by the local board of education.
YES	2	Delay the use of the PARCC assessment for high-stakes purposes (student promotion, teacher evaluation, school grades) for two years.
	2	NMSBA proposes to request the President of the United States and the Congress to overhaul the Elementary and Secondary Education Act to reduce testing mandates, promote multiple forms of evidence of student learning and school quality in accountability and not mandate any fixed role for the use of student test scores in evaluating educators.

- V. Executive Summary:

In an email communication from Mr. Del Hansen, he noted his concern about the NM adopted state assessment (PARCC). Mr. Hansen notes, “It (PARCC) is so far out of step from what we teach as to render the test meaningless, were it not for the fact that it will weigh heavily on drop-out rates, graduation rates, teacher evaluation, and school grades.”

Mr. Hansen will share his concerns with the Board of Education and staff will also provide their perspective on actions taken by the District after the State of New Mexico adopted the Common Core State Mathematics Standards.

Lisa Hufstedler, Secondary Mathematics Specialist, has provided a short brief for the Board as background information to this topic and discussion.

As noted in the LCPS Assessment Plan the PARCC’s Problem-Based Assessment will be first administered in March of 2015 and the PARCC in May.

Common Core State Standards - Mathematics

Briefing Prepared for the Las Cruces Public Schools Board of Education

Lisa Hufstedler, Secondary Mathematics Specialist, Division of Learning, Teaching & Research

Standards Development

Teachers, parents, school administrators, and experts from around the country as well as state leaders developed the Common Core State Standards. The standards are: research and evidence based; clear, understandable, and consistent; aligned with college and career expectations; based on rigorous content and application of knowledge through higher-order thinking skills; built up the strengths and lessons of current state standards; and informed by other top-performing countries to prepare all students for success in our global economy and society.¹

Common Core Standards – Mathematics: Myth versus Fact²

- **Myth:** The standards do not prepare or require students to learn algebra in the 8th grade, as many states' current standards do.
- **Fact:** The standards do accommodate and prepare students for Algebra 1 in 8th grade by including the prerequisites for this course in grades K-7. Students who master the K-7 material will be able to take Algebra 1 in 8th grade. At the same time, grade 8 standards also include rigorous algebra concepts and will transition students effectively into a full Algebra 1 course.
- **Myth:** Key math topics are missing or appear in the wrong grade.
- **Fact:** The mathematical progressions presented in the Common Core State Standards are coherent and based on evidence.

State Developed Standards versus a Consistent Framework Across States

Part of the problem with having different sets of state standards in mathematics is that different states cover different topics at different grade levels. Coming to a consensus guarantees that, from the viewpoint of any given state, topics will move up or down in the grade level sequence. What is important to keep in mind is that the progression in the Common Core State Standards is mathematically coherent and leads to college and career readiness at an internationally competitive level.²

Shifts from New Mexico Mathematics Standards to Common Core Mathematics Standards³

According to the website for the Common Core State Standards Initiative, there are key shifts from state standards to the Mathematics Common Core Standards.

1. Focus – more focus on fewer topics - In 8th grade, the major work of the grade is focused on linear algebra and linear functions. Under the NM Mathematics Standards, this was the major work of Algebra 1. Many of the topics previously taught in 8th grade are now being

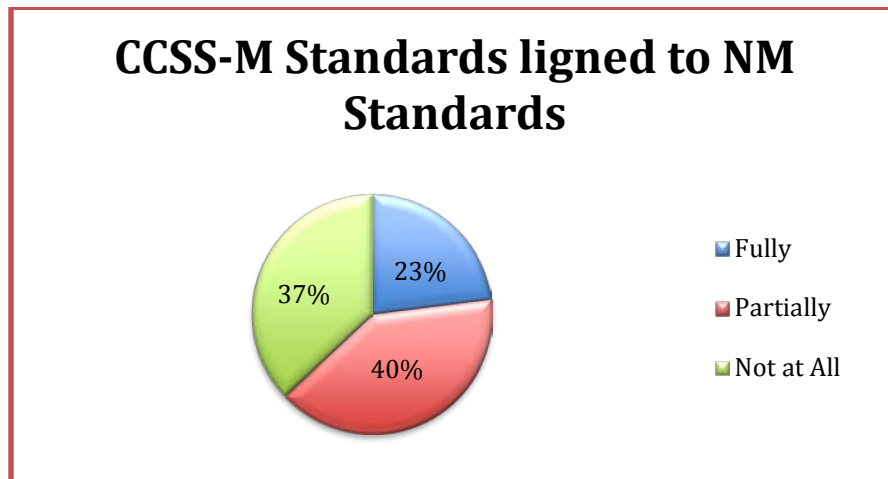

- taught at 6th (algebraic expressions and equations) and 7th grade (arithmetic of rational numbers).
2. Coherence – linking topics and thinking across grades – as students progress through the grades, standards are an extension of previous learning, rather than a new event. Until we have fully bridged the gap between NM Math Standards and CCSS-M, this is a challenge of which we are mindful.
 3. Rigor – pursue conceptual understanding, procedural skills and fluency, and application with equal intensity – Students must have deep, authentic command of mathematical concepts. Students should be able make calculations accurately and efficiently as well as apply math knowledge to real-world situations.

In looking at the Crosswalk created by WestEd in October of 2011 for the State of New Mexico, only 23 percent of the previous New Mexico Standards fully align to CCSS-M. Forty percent of the New Mexico Standards partially align to CCSS-M, meaning that the standard exists in both sets of standards, but in most cases the CCSS-M is much more specific to the related NM standard, ***including essential content not specified in the NM Standards***. Thirty-seven percent of the common core mathematics standards were not addressed at all in the NM Standards. This means that about 77 percent of the Common Core mathematics standards may be new content not previously taught in standard high school mathematics courses (Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2). This accounts for the major shifts of standards that have been previously thought of as Algebra 2 standards into Algebra 1 standards as well as standards previously taught in upper level math courses to Algebra 2.



Pacing Guide Development

The District Pacing Guide teams are comprised of teachers from all middle schools and high schools. The teams consulted a variety of sources to develop the district-pacing guides. All grade/content level teams utilized the Common Core State Standards for Mathematics as well as the PARCC Model Content Frameworks. These frameworks are designed to serve as a bridge between the CCSS-M and the PARCC assessments. Additionally, the frameworks inform the design of assessments and support the implantation of the mathematics standards. They outline key content dependencies, key instructional emphases, and opportunities for in-depth work with key concepts, and connections to critical practices. Additionally, the frameworks define the major work of the grade, supporting standards, and additional standards (<http://parcconline.org/mcf/mathematics/parcc-model-content-frameworks-browser>). At the high school level, teams also consulted Appendix A of the standards. At high school level, the standards

are organized by conceptual category, not by course. Appendix A⁴ provides districts with guidance on how to organize the standards into courses (). Finally, the Pacing Guide teams took into account the resources currently available and recognized the need to regularly revisit the Pacing Guides and view them as a living document. Because of the major shifts in Common Core Standards and the fact that the State of New Mexico adopted them for middle school and high school students, the shift to full implementation of the standards is more gradual in order to fill student knowledge gaps as classroom teachers shift to the new standards.

Professional Development

At the PDC, mathematics specialists are working to ensure that mathematics content is the focus of all professional development for teachers. All secondary math teachers took a sample PARCC test during the fall district professional development day and discussed the implications for students and instruction. As a result, many teachers are working to give their students opportunities to experience and work with the technological interface. Additionally, secondary math teachers have received professional development about raising the level of cognitive demand in math tasks embedded in content. Finally, all secondary teachers are receiving informational PD on the structure and design of PARCC with specific emphasis on the depth of the content standards with connections to the math practices. The end result of this professional learning is designed to assist teachers in using these tools (content standards, math practices, evidence tables, and performance level descriptors) to guide and inform instruction and assessment.
