Some scholarship funds have specific eligibility requirements established by the donor. ***Please review the scholarship descriptions and requirements listed online carefully!*** The Foundation Scholarship Committee will make their selections and the recipient will be notified by email on or around May 2018. While applicants may apply for more than one scholarship, only one (1) will be awarded to an individual. The scholarship checks will be presented to the recipients at their High School's Senior Awards Assembly.
